

Activity: Brainstorming - Safety - How Do We Keep Cool in a Heat Wave?

- 1. Brainstorm with the students what they think they should to keep cool during a heat wave.
- 2. Go over 6 basics:

 - 3. Stay hydrated.
 - 4. Drink cool drinks.
 - 5. Tell Mom or Dad if you are sick

Activity: Developing Creativity - Make a Magic Periscope

Materials: paint, paper, toilet paper rolls for all students

- 1. Explain and show pictures of telescopes, periscopes, and kaleidoscopes.
- 2. Explain how Google Glass is like a 'scope' to help autistic children understand to see people smile.
- 3. Brainstorm with the children something that they wish they could see with their eyes.
- 4. Help the students color and design 'magic' scopes that show them what they want to see.
- 5. Allow the students to share with the class what their magic scope shows them.
